Plastic bags and gloves are provided. Bring your boat, GPS, life jacket, nets, grappling hooks, what you need, and sign a waiver. We will collect trash, noting the location, weight and type. Larger items can be located by GPS and photo for safe removal and disposal by a team. This event helps derelict boat removal efforts.

Plastic bottles may emit harmful chemicals into the water when in the sun. Delta waterways are contaminated with multiple pollutants. Pollution affects our health, and the health of fish and wildlife, possibly contributing to decreased populations and extinction. Plastic and other trash, flow out to ocean and contribute to ocean garbage patches. Plastic pollution is growing so fast that if left unchecked, there could soon be one pound of plastic for every three pounds of fin fish in the ocean. Additionally, plastic in the waterways impacts habitat for wildlife. Delta waterways and the ocean face many challenges from human impacts. Help make a difference by participating in a cleanup!
